

LAPAU Guidance

If you have not already created an account, please do so <u>here</u>. If you will be updating the scheme information and require editing permissions for your local authority please email us at <u>LA-Recycling@wrap.ngo</u> so this can be assigned to you.


You will first need to set your local authority to your account. Select the 'set your LA' text at the top of the Account page. To access this, click on your initials and then to 'Account'.



Search for your local authority - you can do so by typing in the search box or browsing through the LA list.




Once you have found your local authority, first select the 'Set as your LA' tick box, then 'Manage this LA'.



You will now see all the data we hold on your services. We are simply asking you to check and update this information where necessary. Please work through each of the schemes and ensure that you 'submit' the data once you have completed your update.

You can edit core local authority information, such as household numbers, in the left-hand box by clicking 'Edit'. Please update the household numbers in this section before you update the scheme specific sections. The total number of households in this section should equal the number with a residual collection.



Create a new scheme by selecting 'New Scheme +' at the top of each recycling/waste stream and select the green 'Publish' button when you have completed the necessary fields.


To edit existing scheme data, select the pen icon to the right of the screen, make your required changes and select the green 'Publish' button.



When submitting your schemes, where possible please separate kerbside collections from dedicated non-kerbside collections (flats and super rural schemes) using the property type feature.


To the best of your knowledge please provide the start date of the roll out of the service and estimated length of time it took / will take before this is completed.

Please be sure to check that the dry recycling scheme type has been correctly identified. If you believe there is an error please email <u>LA-recycling@wrap.ngo</u> and we will update the scheme type.



To 'Add a container' you will be presented with a list of options - you can select size and colour once you have confirmed the container type. Where the household has the choice of multiple containers, and you are unsure of the exact number of households with each container, please provide your best guess and indicate this in the notes or include the dominant container and list the alternatives in notes.

Please ensure there are enough containers for every household listed on the scheme.



Please review the materials collected each time you update your scheme information as we constantly strive to improve the data collected via the LA Portal.

We have recently added toothpaste tubes, coffee pods and vapes as materials collected at the kerbside. If your authority collects any of these materials, please add them to your scheme information. Additionally, where materials are collected separately from another on dry schemes, please select the appropriate containers and ensure the correct materials are collected. Please add any supplementary comments to the notes sections.
